

WORTH TOWNSHIP MINUTES

February 3, 2026

Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, Fred Brezel, through Zoom, called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Fred then turned the meeting over to Supervisor Shari Kreutz to continue. In addition to Fred Brezel through Zoom, Supervisor Shari Kreutz, Supervisor Brian McMurdy, John Martin, Jason Farone, Ken Moniot, and SRVFD Chief Ryan Hanchosky were present.

Shari Kreutz motioned to accept the December minutes. Fred Brezel made the first motion. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. A vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Shari Kreutz made a motion to accept the January Reorganization meeting minutes. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. Vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Shari Kreutz read the Treasurer's Report. Shari Kreutz made a motion to accept the report. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. A vote was taken on the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Guest Speaker:

Slippery Rock Volunteer Fire Department Chief, Ryan Hanchosky, reported 2025 Fire/EMS calls. Worth Township had 77 callouts, with most involving car accidents. The Fire Department had 6 individuals complete the EMT program and currently has 8 individuals enrolled in 2026. 12 Responders are now water-rescue trained with the help of the County; they are equipped with dry suits. The Department ordered a new Rescue engine, which is expected to be delivered in 3 years. The rescue engine required repairs, with a cost of \$21,000.00. In 3 years, the truck will be 20 years old. Reaching the limit of use. Fundraisers this year include Fish Dinners, Ladies Night, with a possibility of a gun raffle in the fall at Coopers Lake. Mr. Hanchosky thanked the Supervisors for their continued support.

Public Comments: John Martin thanked the Road Crew for doing a great job plowing the roads this winter. Ken Moniot agreed with that sentiment.

Complaints: West Park Road was slippery, snow drifting on Barron Road.

Road Crew Report: Plowed and ashed roads, continued working on the Athey, and received 2 loads of salt.

Planning Commission: Reviewed the Heichel Land Development plan on Kelly Road.

Since it was a small development, the Planning Commission approved submitting a Final Plan and no need for a preliminary plan. Brian McMurdy made a motion to accept the Heichel Plan, noting that only a Final Plan is needed. Shari Kreutz seconded the motion. Vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Shari Kreutz made a motion to approve the Heichel Land Development plan. Fred Brezel seconded the motion. Vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Butler County Planning Commission contacted the Supervisors regarding land development at Coopers Lake Campground. No land development plans were presented to the Township or County. Coopers Lake president, James Brezel, was contacted, and he had submitted a Land Development plan to MDIA, the Township building inspector, but not the Township or County. Mr. Brezel forwarded the plan for Ken Moniot and the planning commission to review.


