

WORTH TOWNSHIP MINUTES

March 3, 2026

Temporary Chairman of the Board of Supervisors, Shari Kreutz, called the meeting to order with the pledge of allegiance to the flag. Those present along with Ms. Kreutz were Supervisor Brian McMurdy, Ken Moniot, John Martin, and Jason Farone.

Shari Kreutz made a motion to accept the February Meeting minutes. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. Vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Shari Kreutz read the Treasurer's Report for February. Shari Kreutz made a motion to accept the report. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. A vote was taken on the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Comments: John Martin mentioned the signs for Cornelius and Reichert Road were missing, and there were building materials along Cornelius Road, and wanted to know if there were any building permits for anyone on Cornelius Road.

Planning Commission: Ken Moniot had concerns with Coopers Lake and the lack of a land development plan for a new building in the campground. He spoke with James from Coopers Lake, and James told Ken the plans were brought to the office in March of 2025. As secretary, I informed Ken Moniot that no land development plans had been brought into the office at the time. Coopers Lake had applied for a building permit in March of 2025. MDIA requested a Land development plan from Coopers Lake. Coopers Lake then submitted it to MDIA. It wasn't until February of 2026 that the Township received an incomplete Land Development plan from Coopers Lake. After some discussion about the Township Supervisors being lax in enforcing land development, Ken Moniot said he would contact James from Coopers Lake. Heichel Land Development is still not resolved, as the plan has not been brought in for signature and recorded at the Butler County Recorder of Deeds. Ken Moniot said the Supervisors should consult with the Township solicitor to resolve the Heichel property.

Road Crew Report: Plowed and ashed roads, cut trees off roads, painted Athey

New Business: Shari Kreutz made a motion to order 172 tons of salt for the 2026-2027 winter season. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. Vote was taken. Motion carried unanimously.

Shari Kreutz made a motion to adopt the resolution to apply for a MAP grant to help with the cost of updating the Multi-Municipal Comprehensive Plan. Brian McMurdy seconded the motion. Vote as taken. Motion carried unanimously.


